Treasurer Report

- Present July Income and Expense Report
 - We continue to balance with Budget breakdown as follows:
 - 9% in reserve (ideally would like 10-11%)
 - 16% for Operations
 - 39% for Maintenance
 - 17% for Gardener Amenities
 - 19% for Community Outreach
 - o Discussions/Suggestions around sub-categories under each of these main expense categories
